I have been asked about my key issues. I have several. Narrowing them down to three they include:

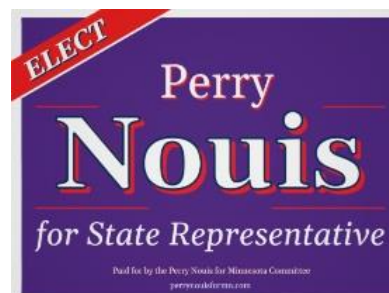

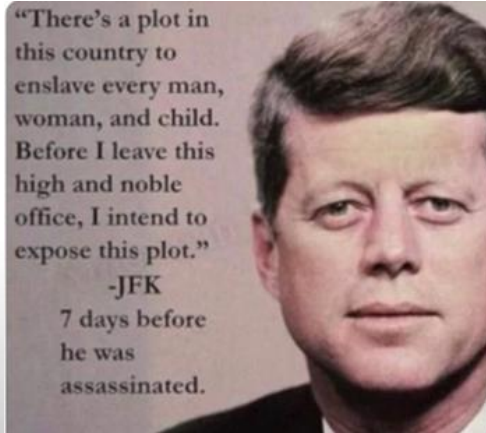
"What are you VOTING for as a Republican?"

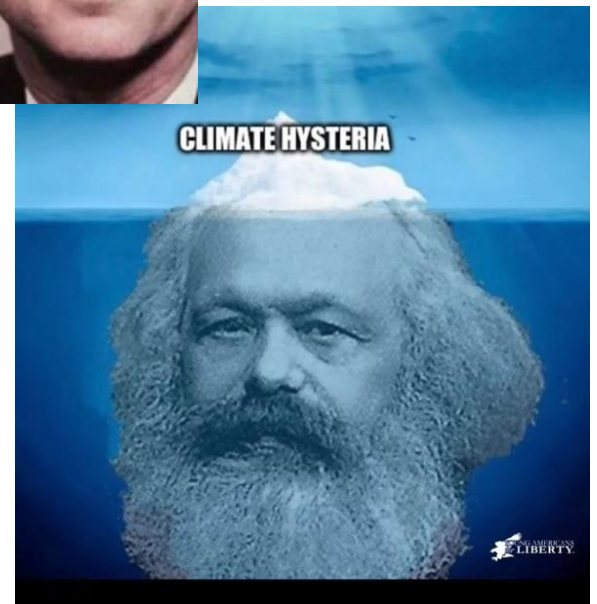
